

Self-promotion (Resumes, ePortfolios, Interviews)

OVERVIEW

As with any new job search planning your first nursing career step takes time, commitment, and professional preparation. The first step of the process involves some self-analysis to figure out where you would like to work, what you are qualified to do, what geographic region you are open to, and how you can find out what opportunities currently exist for your selected target areas. The next step is the preparation of your



resume and portfolio to present you in a professional and accurate light. This includes writing customized cover letters tailored for each job prospect. Once an interview is arranged, steps to prepare you for the best interview possible will help to ensure that this nerve-wracking part of the process goes smoothly.

The work done in this program has prepared you well to work with an electronic portfolio. These skills can be applied to tailor a portfolio that presents your resume and other documents in an appealing, easy to access format. Your portfolio should not replace a resume and cover letter, but it can definitely supplement them with unique evidence that showcases your individual talents and abilities in concrete ways. More and more, skills that show that you know how to use technology are important in the nursing arena. A well designed ePortfolio can provide tangible evidence of some of these skills.
